This qualification outlines a range of practical skills for providing first aid to adults, children and infants. Learners will practise assessing and managing an incident and demonstrate how to treat a variety of serious conditions.

Course content	
The role of the first aider	Bleeding (including catastrophic bleeds)
Infection control	Bites and Stings
Recording/reporting incidents and accidents	Eye, ear and nose conditions
Incident and casualty assessment	Fractures, dislocations, sprains and strains
Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR)	Head and spinal injuries
Safe use of an Automated External Defibrillator	Special conditions – e.g. Diabetes, asthma, meningitis,
Unconscious casualty	Extremes of body temperature
Epilepsy and Seizures (inc febrile convulsions)	Electric shock
Choking	Burns and scalds
Anaphylaxis	Poisons
Shock	Minor injuries

Course duration will be 12 hours, excluding breaks, this is normally covered within 2 days, but we offer the flexibility to schedule the course over three sessions of four hours.
